

Mission objectives and targets

Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030

PROTECT AND RESTORE MARINE
AND FRESHWATERS ECOSYSTEMS
AND BIODIVERSITY

- Protect at least 30% and strictly protect 10% EU's sea areas
- Restore 25.000 km free flowing rivers
- Marine nature restoration targets (incl. degraded seabeds, coastal ecosystems)

PREVENT AND ELIMINATE
POLLUTION OF OUR OCEANS,
SEAS AND WATERS

- Reduce by at least 50% plastic litter
- Reduce by at least 30% microplastics
- Reduce by at least 50% nutrient losses, chemical pesticides

Implementing the Mission Ocean and Waters

1. Mobilisation of relevant actors

Mission Lighthouses: established frameworks for basin-level cooperation

Mission Charter: >600 actions with EUR 5.5bn, incl. buy-in from MS, regions, cities

Mission Forum: Annual gathering of Mission community

Blue Parks community: growing community of >80 members sharing knowledge, practices and assistance

Digital Ocean Forum: Building the community of practitioners delivering the DTO

Young people: volunteering (ESC), citizen science (Plastic Pirates), literacy (blue schools)

2. Supporting the transitions

Developing and demonstrating solutions: Growing portfolio of 66 projects with solutions tried and tested in >200 demo sites.

Associated regions: Making solutions available to >100 regions

DTO: Delivered the prototype DTO in June 2024

Support communities: technical assistance to 50 + 100 communities

Implementation platform:

Matchmaking, support services, solutions portal, etc.

3. Deployment at scale

Financial support: synergies with structural funds, RRF, EMFAF, etc

Regions: development of Cooperation Working Arrangements to align and leverage funds

Blue Champions: financial advisory to 20 SMEs with EIB

Philanthropy: Alignment of public and private funds






Mission Charter actions


Currently 639 accepted Mission Charter actions (over 800 submitted) with a total budget of over EUR 6 billion










EU Blue Champions unveiled: 20 companies will receive advisory support to grow their business

 Originating from Croatia, Denmark, France Germany, Greece, Italy, Portugal, Spain, Sweden and Norway, these champions are involved in various sectors ranging from tidal and wind energy solutions to underwater robotics, satellite data applications, and biorefinery activities









SUPPORTING the Mission Communities for local deployment

EC support :

- EC support to regions, local authorities, islands to prepare transition
 agendas + community-led pilot actions : services and feasibility studies
- Facilitating investments to implement the actions: MIP service portal, EIB Blue Champions, matchmaking with investors /philanthropies ...
- **Synergies** and 'pacts with Regions': negotiation with Regions to invest structural funds in Mission actions / transition agendas supported by the EC (pilot on-going)

- The amount was entirely distributed to volunteering activities
- Contribution agreements with 31 programme countries (27 MS + Iceland, Liechtenstein, North Macedonia and Türkiye.)
- Results: 465 projects for "environmental protection, sustainable development and climate action" + 365 under "projects green practices".
